Moses Henochs Altschul-Jeruschalmi "Brantspiegel" Jul 18 2019 Moses Henochs «Brantspiegel» ist das im 17. und
18. Jahrhundert wohl bekannteste jüdischdeutsche Moralbuch. Es war für die jüdische Frau bestimmt und enthält
eine Fülle von Material, an dem sich Einblick gewinnen läßt in das jüdische Leben des 16. Jahrhunderts. Bisher

help the user read and translate English, German, French, Dutch and Russian texts in electrical engineer ing. Up
until now all such dictionaries were containing terms pertaining directly to electrical engineering plus the
terminology used in its off-sheets which have evolved into separate disci plines, such as communications,
electronics, automation etc. Foremost, however, this Diction ary represents the terminology of electrical
engineering, while the branches are represented by their basic terms only. Given the relative small volume (about
8000 terms), the authors tried to reflect the most important terms in such areas as the circuit theory, electric and

magnetic measurements, electric power generation, transmission and distribution, as well as the industrial and domestic consumption of electric power. The Dictionary also contains many terms relevant to high voltage technology, electrical machines and apparatus, electric drive, as well as to the elements and structures of aerial and cable transmission lines. In selecting English terms, the authors were trying to reflect both their British and American versions, although they did not attempt to present all terminological synonyms of this kind. In some cases the Dictionary provides the main spelling versions.

Reproducing the French Race Jul 10 2021 In *Reproducing the French Race*, Elisa Camiscioli argues that immigration was a defining feature of early-twentieth-century France, and she examines the political, cultural, and social issues implicated in public debates about immigration and national identity at the time. Camiscioli demonstrates that mass immigration provided politicians, jurists, industrialists, racial theorists, feminists, and others with ample opportunity to explore questions of French racial belonging, France's relationship to the colonial empire and the rest of Europe, and the connections between race and national anxieties regarding depopulation and degeneration. She also shows that discussions of the nation and its citizenry consistently returned to the body: its color and gender, its expenditure of labor power, its reproductive capacity, and its experience of desire. Of paramount importance was the question of which kinds of bodies could assimilate into the "French race." By focusing on telling aspects of the immigration debate, Camiscioli reveals how racial hierarchies were constructed, how gender figured in their creation, and how only white Europeans were cast as assimilable. Delving into pronatalist politics, she describes how potential immigrants were ranked according to their imagined capacity to adapt to the workplace and family life in France. She traces the links between racialized categories and concerns about industrial skills and output, and she examines medico-hygienic texts on interracial sex, connecting those to the crusade against prostitution and the related campaign to abolish "white slavery," the alleged entrapment of (white) women for sale into prostitution abroad. Camiscioli also explores the debate surrounding the 1927 law that first made it possible for French women who married foreigners to keep their French nationality. She concludes by linking the Third Republic's impulse to create racial hierarchies to the emergence of the Vichy regime.

Signature Derrida Aug 31 2020 Throughout his long career, Jacques Derrida had a close, collaborative relationship with *Critical Inquiry* and its editors. He saved some of his most important essays for the journal, and he relished the ensuing arguments and polemics that stemmed from the responses to his writing that *Critical Inquiry* encouraged. Collecting the best of Derrida's work that was published in the journal between 1980 and 2002, *Signature Derrida* provides a remarkable introduction to the philosopher and the evolution of his thought. These essays define three significant "periods" in Derrida's writing: his early, seemingly revolutionary phase; a middle stage, often autobiographical, that included spirited defense of his work; and his late period, when his persona as a public intellectual was prominent, and he wrote on topics such as animals and religion. The first period is represented by essays like "The Law of Genre," in which Derrida produces a kind of phenomenological narratology. Another essay, "The Linguistic Circle of Geneva," embodies the second, presenting deconstructionism at its best: Derrida shows that what was imagined to be an epistemological break in the study of linguistics was actually a repetition of earlier concepts. The final period of Derrida's writing includes the essays "Of Spirit" and "The Animal That Therefore I Am (More to Follow)," and three eulogies to the intellectual legacies of Michel Foucault, Louis Marin, and Emmanuel Lévinas, in which Derrida uses the ideas of each thinker to push forward the implications of their theories. With an introduction by Françoise Meltzer that provides an overview of the oeuvre of this singular philosopher, *Signature Derrida* is the most wide-ranging, and thus most representative, anthology of Derrida's work to date.
